- 5.1 Discuss and act on HHSA rejection of JPA FY 15/16 Draft 4 budget
  - Executive Director Hackett discussed response from HHSA rejecting Draft 4 as amended. He reviewed the staff report with suggestion for budget reductions with the Board.

**Motion** by Chief Roberts to reduce class 30 for County Fire by the \$637k that was added for one-half time medic unit 26 and remove the \$650k for class 60 fixed assets, motion was seconded by Chief Bement and carries by majority vote.
