5.2 EDC ESA IFT Pilot Project

 Reviewed the Pilot Project document and statistics for the first 15 days of the pilot. Staff expressed concern on the limited timeframe of the initial pilot document. Difficult to get accurate data with only 3 months. With the fluctuations in weather and tourism, the impact to the system could be greatly affected but we would not accurately capture that data in 3 months. Would like to consider extending the project to one year. Staff will continue to provide monthly reports of the statistics.

 Direction given to staff to evaluate the timeline of the pilot project and bring a recommendation to the next BOD meeting. Staff to also communicate request to LEMSA for input.

6.2 EDC ESA Move Up/Cover Pilot Project
